


WARRANTY:


This product was designed and intended for light duty, residential use. Improper installation, abuse, improper use of the product or use of this product in a commercial environment will void this warranty.




TIPS for ASSEMBLY


- Avoid over tightening the camlocks, they only need enough torque to bring the parts together. Additional torque will damage them.
- Avoid over tightening the camlock studs, they only need to be seated. Over tightening can damage the stud or the panels.
- Once installed, avoid removing the T-Molding. Doing so may loosen the grip of the panels.
- Installation of buttons and electronics may be easier if done before attaching the panels to the main assembly.
- There are indicators on panels where electronics and other components mount. Use a 2.5mm (3/32 in) drill bit set to a depth of no more than 10mm (3/8 in) to predrill as needed.
- A small bar type clamp can be used instead of the rubber mallet to install the camlocks. This will allow for a more precise installation, avoiding the rotation that occasionally happens when using the mallet.
- When installing the Monitor Bezel, use double stick tape or hook and loop tape to mount.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


1. Install T-Molding in all of the slotted parts and trim to fit.





When making tight bends, it helps to cut a notch in the underside of the T-Molding as illustrated here. This will prevent the T-Molding from slipping out and creating gaps.





2. Install Camlocks and Camlock Studs into all parts as indicated in the following illustrations




















3. Assemble the A, B and D Panels with the A and B panels on their backs and the camlocks on the D Panel facing the bottom of the unit.



4. Install the C Panel while the unit is still on it back.



5. Install the F Panel, again, leaving the unit on its back.



Carefully turn the unit upright for all other assembly steps.

6. Install the G panel




7. Choose the orientation for the monitor and install the I panel. You will need to lift the G panel as it will rotate on the camlocks, align the G panel to the I panel so that the camlocks engage the camlock studs on the G panel.




8. Install the H Panel, this is a good time to install buttons, joystick and wiring. Turn the unit around and use the stubby screwdriver to secure the camlocks.




9. From the back of the unit install the E panel. This is a good time to install the electronic components.




10. Install the K Panels




11. Install the lower J Channel and Marquee. Use the Marquee to set the location of the lower J channel, then drill 5, 3mm (7/64") holes for the M3x13 mounting screws. Use the existing holes in the J Channel as a guide.



12. Install the upper J Channel using the same process
